**Author Glen Jeansonne to Speak at the  
Herbert Hoover Presidential Library-Museum  
Saturday, July 14 at 1:30 p.m.**

West Branch, Iowa – On Saturday, July 14 at 1:30 author and historian Glen Jeansonne will present a book talk in the Hoover Museum auditorium on his latest book, *The Life of Herbert Hoover: Fighting Quaker, 1928-1933*. This event is free and open to the public.

This book is the fifth in the series *The Life of Herbert Hoover*, a series sponsored by the Herbert Hoover Presidential Library Association. Jeansonne provides new insight into America's least understood chief executive with the first book-length study of the Hoover presidency that has been written in a generation. Former director Timothy Walch said, "This book is destined to become the standard account of the Hoover presidency."

Glen Jeansonne is Professor of History at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee. He has written scores of articles and fourteen books. His books include *A Time of Paradox: America since 1890*, *Changing Times: The Life of Barack Obama*, and *Gerald L. K. Smith: Minister of Hate*. Jeansonne's book on Smith was nominated for the Pulitzer Prize in 1988.

*The Life of Herbert Hoover: Fighting Quaker* will be available for purchase at the Museum Gift Shop and Jeansonne will sign books following his talk.

The Herbert Hoover Presidential Library-Museum is one of thirteen museums operated by the National Archives and Records Administration. Located in West Branch, Iowa just off Interstate 80 at Exit 254. The Book Talk is at 1:30 p.m. and there is no charge for this event, regular museum fees are charged to go through the galleries.
